## AUTUMN LEAVES 2009 SCHEDULE

Fall is approaching and with it the laborious task of raking fallen leaves. We strongly recommend that you mulch your leaves and return this very beneficial material back to your lawn and landscape. Surplus leaves can be disposed of by the following methods:

1. Leaves may be bagged in biodegradable paper bags (with a self-adhesive yard waste sticker attached) or placed in yard waste totes as you would any other yard waste. Your disposal company will pick up this waste on Mondays. For further information on the stickers and totes, contact the Village Hall at 368-5000.
2. Leaves may be raked to the street pavement edge where they will be collected four times by the Village per the schedule below. In order to have an efficient and effective program, your cooperation is needed in adhering to the following procedures:
  - **DO NOT** bag your leaves if you want the Village to pick them up. The equipment we use can only pick up piles of loose leaves.
  - Rake **ONLY LEAVES** into a pile. **NO shrub clippings, sticks, or other debris are permitted, as these materials will clog our equipment.**
  - **DO NOT** pile leaves on the street pavement. This can and does create hazards for pedestrians and vehicular traffic. Leaves are to be placed behind the curb or edge of pavement.
  - To insure that leaves do not remain on your property for any length of time, please place the leaves a day or two prior to the dates listed below. Any leaves placed afterwards will not be collected until the next date. *As always, the later pickups are subject to weather conditions.*
